

ADJOURNED MEETING CITY COUNCIL
June 8, 2015

The City Council of the City of Albemarle met in an adjourned session on Monday, June 8, 2015, at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall. Mayor Michael presided and the following Councilmembers were present, to wit: Mayor Pro Tem Troy E. Alexander, Bill Aldridge, Benton Dry, Martha Sue Hall, Martha Hughes, Dexter Townsend and Chris Whitley. Absent, none.

Mayor Michael brought the meeting to order.

Upon a motion by Councilmember Hall, seconded by Councilmember Alexander, and unanimously carried, the City Council appointed Councilmember Hughes as acting clerk.

Upon a motion by Councilmember Hall, seconded by Councilmember Townsend, and unanimously carried, the City Council adjourned to a closed session pursuant to NCGS 143-318.11 (a) (6) to discuss personnel issues.

Upon a motion by Councilmember Alexander, seconded by Councilmember Dry, and unanimously carried, the City Council reconvened to open session. Mayor Michael announced that a closed session was held pursuant to NCGS 143-318.11 (a) (6) to discuss personnel issues and there was nothing to disclose at this time.

Councilmember Dry complimented the Police for taking into custody the convict we had recently been sent a press release on.

Councilmember Hall asked that we keep David Morgan's comments about our budget in the forefront of our mind and review them again as the year progresses.

Councilmember Hall also spoke about the conference call at City Hall on Thursday, June 4 with Greenville Kentucky's City Manager. Participating in the call were Mayor Michael, Councilmember Hughes and Hall, Economic Development Director Mark

Donham, and City Manager Michael Ferris. The topic was regarding economic development that took place in Greenville City. This presentation was shown at the NLC Conference in Austin, Texas that Councilmember Hughes and Councilmember Hall attended last fall. A PowerPoint presentation was sent to the City Manager and will be forwarded to those Councilmembers that were not a part of the conference call.

Councilmember Hall also spoke to Economic Development Director Mark Donham about a possible tenant for the Shops at Olive Place and she reported that he advised that Retail Strategies is assisting in this effort.
