

SPECIAL MEETING CITY COUNCIL

August 23, 2021

The City Council of the City of Albemarle met in a special session for a closed session for consultation with the City Attorney and a personnel item, on Monday, August 23rd at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers of City Hall. Mayor Ronnie Michael was not present, and so Mayor Pro Tempore Martha Sue Hall presided. The following Councilmembers were present, to-wit: Martha E.
