

SPECIAL MEETING CITY COUNCIL

August 30, 2021

The City Council of the City of Albemarle met in a special session to discuss personnel items and to consult with the City Attorney in closed session on Monday, August 30th at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers of City Hall.
