

RECESSED MEETING CITY COUNCIL

July 18, 2022

The City Council of the City of Albemarle met in a recessed session on Monday, July 18, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers of City Hall. Mayor Ronnie Michael presided, and the following members were present, to-wit: Mayor Pro Tempore Martha Sue Hall and Councilmembers, Martha E. Hughes, Chris Whitley, Benton Dry, Dexter Townsend, and Shirley D. Lowder. Absent, Councilmember Bill Aldridge.

Mayor Michael called the meeting to order.

Mayor Michael announced he intends to end his State of Emergency Declaration for the City of Albemarle in August when Governor Cooper ends the Statewide Emergency Declaration.

Mayor Michael reported that Jordan Jones has offered to provide the Mayor and City Council a walk through of the Residences at Albemarle in the late summer or early fall timeframe. City Manager Michael Ferris noted the City plans to highlight its role in bringing this project to a reality as an example of the economic development activities and support it undertakes for the betterment of our community.
