The City Council held a dinner meeting with the members of the Planning and Zoning Board and Zoning Board of Adjustment.

Mayor Whitley indicated that the City Council recently permitted the Stanly County School System to proceed with construction at Albemarle High School with obtaining the required Conditional Use Permit because the School System had not received one, yet was ready to begin construction.

He said that as a result, the City Council has asked the Planning and Zoning Board to consider making a recommendation to reclassify all existing school property to a new zone called Institutional. This would allow the schools to be a permitted use in this district.
