KEEP ALBEMARLE CLEAN ADOPT-A-STREET PROGRAM AGREEMENT

Keep Albemarle Clean, Adopt-A-Street Organization and

(Name of business, organization or individual, hereinafter the “Entity”) recognize the need and the desirability of litter-free and visually improved streets.

The Adopt-A-Street program has been established for community and civic organizations as well as private businesses and industry to contribute toward the effort of maintaining cleaner and more beautiful streets in the City of Albemarle. The purpose of the Keep Albemarle Clean Adopt-A-Street program is to encourage community residents and organizations to adopt residential blocks of streets and keep them litter-free. The entity will clean the adopted area every three months in an effort to maintain a healthy environment and to produce feelings of pride in our beautiful city.

The Entity understands that the work to be performed can result in physical injury or damage to property and agrees to assume the risk. The Entity hereby agrees to release and hold harmless the City of Albemarle and any Neighborhood Committee, their officers, employees and agents respectively from liability for any and all claims, damages or injuries of any kind or nature which the Entity, its employees, members or agents may cause or suffer as a result of participation in the program. All volunteers are required to be 12 years old or older. The Entity agrees that the City of Albemarle will install signs bearing the group’s name at the City's discretion.

City of Albemarle recognizes the Entity as the adopting organization for

Street Name and Description (from what point to what point)

The Entity volunteers are to pick up litter at least every 3 months (or more if necessary) along its section of street for a period beginning ____/____/____, and ending ____/____/____.

Contract commitment is for 1 year. A minimum 3-year commitment is required if City of Albemarle posts an Adopt-A-Street sign.

Items provided for clean up: Clean-up reports (to be turned in after each clean-up), latex gloves, trash bags, and safety vests. If safety vests are misplaced, the group is responsible for replacement.

***Items collected by Adopt-A-Street participants should be litter and debris that can fit into trash bags provided. The City of Albemarle and the Public Works Street Division will pick up tires and some bulky items that are litter on the public right of way—not on private property. The Adopt-A-Street contact person should call City of Albemarle Public Works Department the working day following a clean up to report where bags of trash are left.
